- 2011-2012 Implementation Roll-out

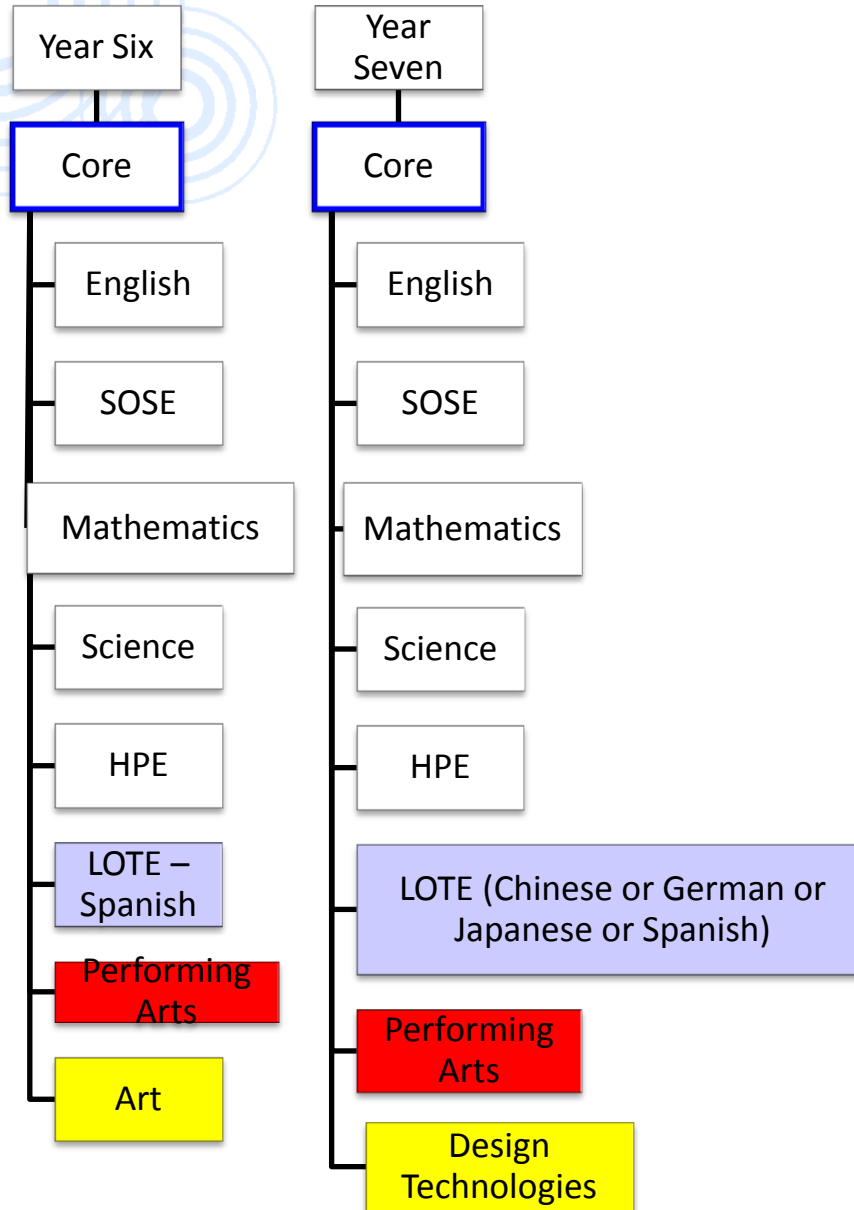

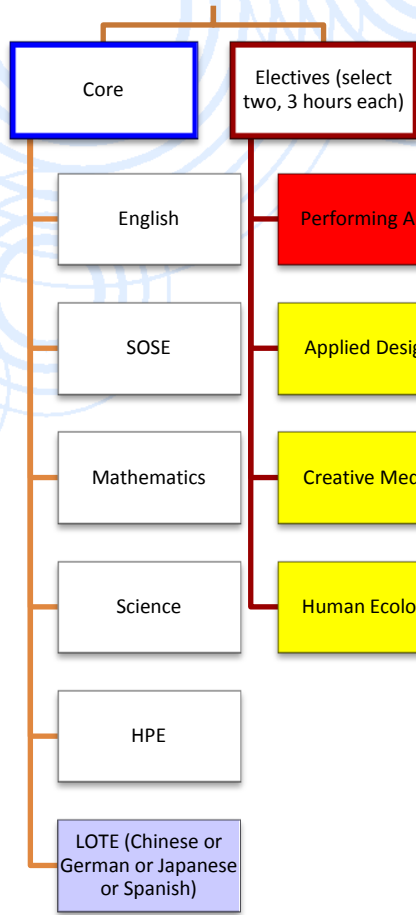
- 2010 time of change

 - Australian Curriculum 2012



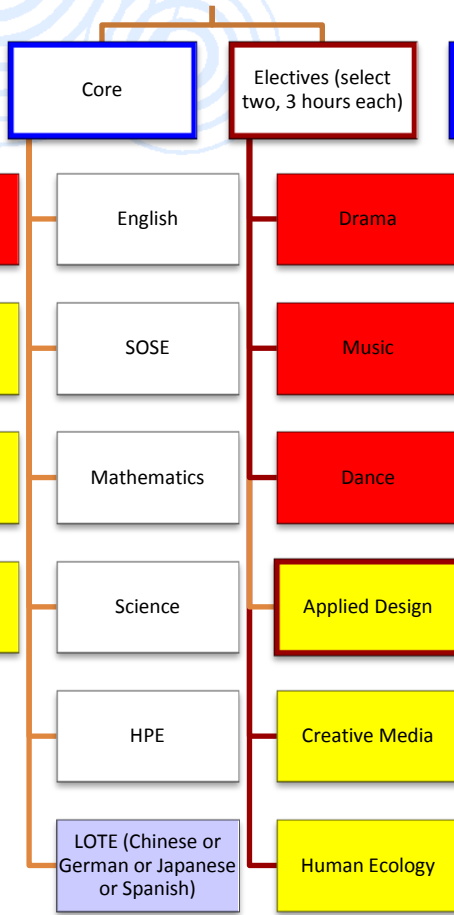
Year 6-7 Transition



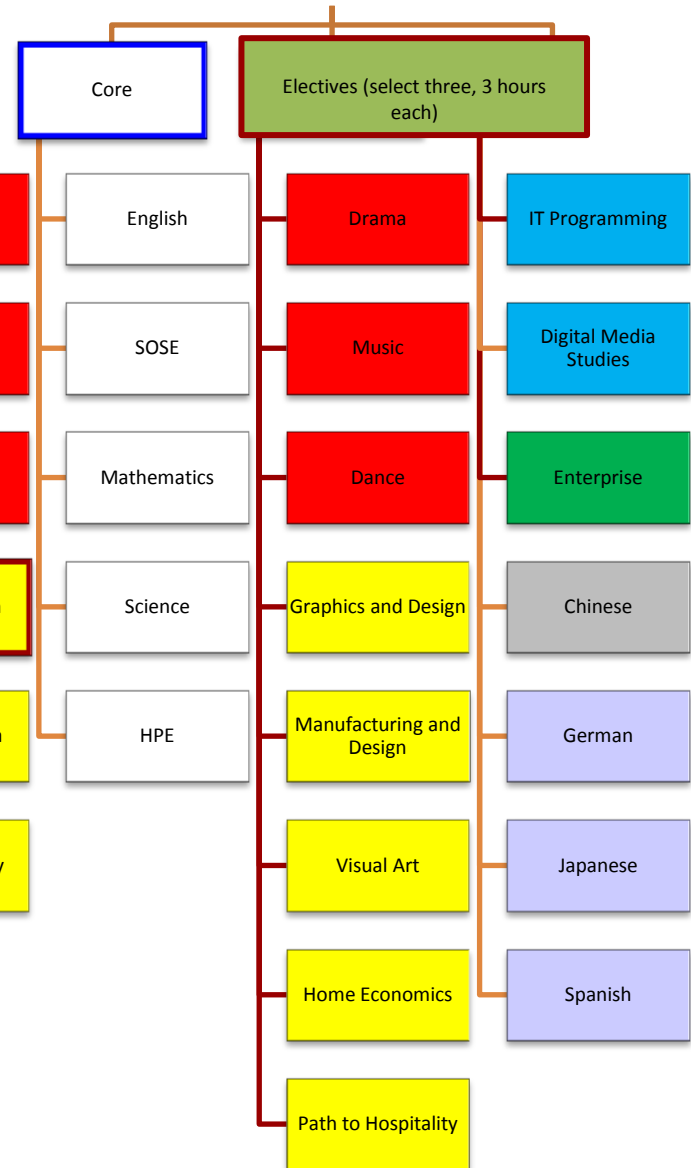
