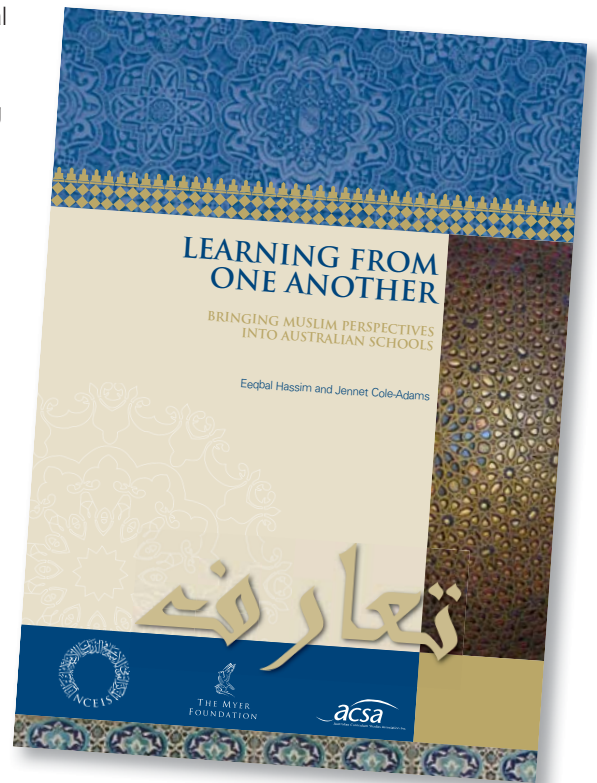
Learning from One Another is a new resource providing information, practical advice, and classroom strategies for teachers in all Australian schools.
