Standard ACSA membership

- ▶ **Personal** membership for an individual is \$170 per annum (plus \$60 per webinar).
- ▶ **Institutional** membership for the whole school is \$255 per annum (plus \$60 per webinar per person).
- ▶ **Concession, student and retired** membership for an individual is \$90 (plus \$60 per webinar).

New ACSA Institutional Plus membership

- ▶ **Institutional Plus 1** membership for schools with one to five teachers on staff is \$1100 per annum.
- ▶ **Institutional Plus 2** membership for schools with six to 25 teachers on staff is \$1600 per annum.
- ▶ **Institutional Plus 3** membership for schools with 26 or more teachers on staff is \$2100 per annum.
